

# PERENNIALS TO PLANT WITH SPRING BULBS



Perennial Name	Light	Bulbs	Notes
Creeping Phlox ( <i>Phlox subulata</i> )	Sun	Daffodil, hyacinth, tulip	Planting together creates an explosion of brightly colored flowers in the garden.
Peony ( <i>Paeonia</i> )	Sun	Gladiolus, hyacinth, scilla	These taller spring bulbs have unique colorful flowers that compliment classic peony blooms.
Fern ( <i>Athyrium</i> )	Part sun/shade	Fritillaria, lily, snowdrop	Fern foliage provides contrast to vibrant spring bulbs & bulks up quickly while still allowing light to the bulbs.
Coral Bells ( <i>Heuchera</i> )	Part sun/shade	Crocus, iris, snowdrop	Pairing these brighten up foliage-heavy shady areas & helps mask spent bulbs after blooming.
Bleeding Heart ( <i>Dicentra</i> )	Part sun/shade	Chionodoxa, crocus, snowdrop	Blooms simultaneously as many spring bulbs, & radiant foliage provides interest after spring.
